MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION

The work session of the City Council was called to order at 5:33 P.M. All members were present. General municipal business was discussed and the agenda was reviewed. No business was conducted. The work session was adjourned at 6:00 P.M.

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

Mayor Dellinger called the meeting to order at 6:01 P.M.

Council Member Stringer gave the invocation and Council Member Key led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Administrative Assistant Scott Johnston conducted roll call. All members were present. Mayor Dellinger announced a quorum.

The minutes for the July 26, 2016 work session and regular meeting were approved as corrected.

Council Member Stringer made a motion to accept a proposal from Lee County, Alabama at install 72 feet of 24 inch pipe for a new road accessing the new soccer park on Lee Road 246 for \$1,459.44 plus an additional \$250.00 installation fee for a total cost of \$1,709.44. Council Member key seconded the motion. The roll call vote was as follows:

Mayor Dellinger presented information on installing a gate at the entrance to the new soccer park. SL Green Incorporated has provided an estimate of \$3,500.00 - \$4,500.00 for materials, labor and installation. After discussion, the Council asked for more information prior to making a decision.

Mayor Dellinger addressed the council concerning the upcoming elections. Council Member Key made a motion to appoint Administrative Specialist Scott Johnston Assistant Election Manager. Council Member Cooley seconded the motion. The roll call vote was as follows: Yeas: Council Members Moody, Cooley, Key, Stringer, Jackson, Mayor Dellinger. Nays: None. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

Resident Alice Spangler spoke to the council regarding Lee Road 728. She also inquired about the gas tax and its usage.

Council Member Stringer encouraged everyone to attend the Dedication Ceremonies of the Adonica Ferguson Memorial Basketball Courts on August 27, 2016 at 10:00 A.M.

Having no further business, Council Member Key made the motion to adjourn. Council Member Jackson seconded the motion. The motion passed and at 6:18 PM the meeting was adjourned.
