AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SMITHS STATION, ALABAMA, TO ESTABLISH FINES FOR SPECIFIC ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF SMITHS STATION, ALABAMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF; SMITHS STATION, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. On December 12, 2003; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2003-021, and;

On May 2, 2006; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Resolution PC 2006-001, and;

On August 22, 2006; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2006-030, and;

On June 26, 2007; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2006-030.1, and;

On November 27, 2007; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2007-049, and;

On March 11, 2008; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2008-051, and;

On March 24, 2009; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2009-062, and;

On March 23, 2010; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2010-067, and;

On August 9, 2011; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2011-075, and;

On August 26, 2014; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2014-103, and;

On November 11, 2014; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2014-104, and;

On September 27, 2016; the City of Smiths Station City Council voted to approve and adopt Ordinance 2016-119, and;

the City of Smiths Station approves the provisions listed in "Exhibit A".

ORDINANCE 2017-123

Section 3. Pursuant to Code of Alabama 1975, 11-45-9 et seq. all plaintiffs who plead guilty shall pay all applicable fine (s) within thirty (30) calendar days to The City of Smiths Station, Alabama; and the City Council is hereby authorized to bring civil action in any court of competent jurisdiction to enjoin any action of an owner or developer which is in violation of the provisions of Code of Alabama 1975, 11-52-1 et seq., Act 90-195 or any of the regulations set out herein. In such action, the City Council shall be entitled to seek an injunction and may recover penalties as set out in these regulations and Code of Alabama 1975, 11-52-1 et seq.



In addition to all provisions of law relating to the Ordinances and Resolutions in the City of Smiths Station, Alabama, there is adopted by the City of Smiths Station, Alabama, all laws of the State of Alabama, pertaining to Ordinances and Resolutions as set forth in the Code of Alabama 1975.

Now therefore be it ordained by the City Council of Smiths Station, Alabama, that this ordinance becomes effective immediately upon adoption and approval.




