

**ORDINANCE 2017-127**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SMITHS STATION, ALABAMA, TO EMPOWER THE CITY TO ESTABLISH, GENERAL POLICE POWERS, CONTROL AND MAINTAIN THE HEALTH AND CLEANLINESS OF ITS CITY AS PROVIDED BY STATE LAW REFERENCE CODE OF ALABAMA 1975 AS AMENDED TITLE 11 CHAPTER 47 ARTICLES 4 AND 5.**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Smiths Station has an obligation to the citizens to enforce general police powers and to maintain the health and cleanliness of the City, and;

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the City to establish enforceable ordinances and regulations, and;


**WHEREAS**, The City advocates consistency of Its Ordinances with the State of Alabama of Alabama.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SMITHS STATION, ALABAMA** as follows:

That the City Council of the City of Smiths Station, Alabama does hereby adopt Title 11, Chapter 47, Article 4 and 5 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended.

All ordinances, or parts or ordinances heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Smiths Station, Alabama that are inconsistent with the provisions of the ordinance are hereby repealed.




